IISc

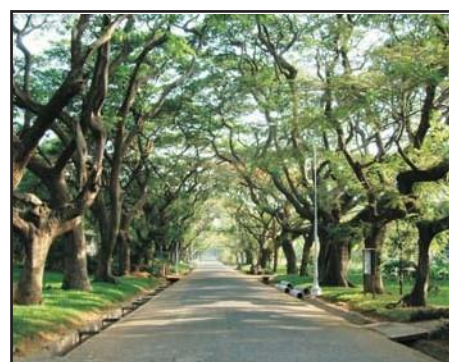
